Let us examine the term "affliction," which refers to something that causes pain or suffering. This can encompass various conditions, such as disorders, diseases, and ailments.


This does not just have to be the fleshly kind, but it is the spiritual that hurts the most-

The Priority of healthy Relationships: there is emphasis here that God values our biblical relationships with others. Before we approach Him in worship, we must ensure that our hearts are free from unresolved issues.

Worship as Relationship: Worship is fundamentally about relationship—both our relationship with God and with others. When Jesus instructs us to reconcile before offering our gifts, He emphasizes that our worship should not be merely ritualistic but rooted in genuine connection and love.



- 2Co 5:17 Therefore if any man *be* in Christ, *he is* a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.
- 2Co 5:18 And all things *are* of God, who hath reconciled us to himself by Jesus Christ, and hath given to us the ministry of reconciliation.
- 2Co 5:19 To wit, that God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto himself, not imputing their trespasses unto them; and hath committed unto us the word of reconciliation.



When there is unresolved conflict, whether it is within yourself or others, it affects not only our personal peace but also the unity of the church body. God wants us to live in harmony with one another as well as ourselves.





You know, when someone says something evil about you, and you want to take it up and get angry about it, that shows that you haven't went quite deep enough yet with God. - •Php 2:3 Let nothing be done through strife or vainglory; but in lowliness of mind let each esteem other better than themselves.
- Php 2:4 Look not every man on his own things, but every man also on the things of others.



Reflecting God's Character: Forgiveness & reconciliation mirrors the heart of God, who forgives us freely. When we forgive others, we reflect His love and grace, making our worship more authentic.



Jhn 4:23 But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship him. Jhn 4:24 God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in ruth.



Jesus describes true worshipers as those who worship God in spirit and truth. This means that worship must come from the heart and align with God's character and His truth. When there is ill will or unresolved conflict in our hearts, it obstructs the authenticity of our worship.
